About the Organizer	<p>China Foreign Affairs University (CFAU), under the guidance of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of China, is an institution of higher learning aimed at preparing high caliber personnel for foreign service, international studies, and other careers related to international business and law. The University was founded in September 1955 at the initiative of the late Premier Zhou Enlai. Over the past 50 years, China Foreign Affairs University has turned out nearly 20,000 graduates, who have become excellent talents in the fields of Diplomacy, Foreign Affairs and International Studies, where there is a five-star national flag flying, you may find alumni of CFAU, it thus has become a "cradle of diplomats" in its own right.</p> <p>CFAU offers Doctoral, Master and Bachelor degrees, specialties such as diplomacy, English, French, Japanese, Law, International Economy and Trade, and International Relations are offered to students. In 2015 there are approximately 2000 enrolled Chinese students and 150 international students on campus. At present, there are 200 full-time faculty members, among whom 64% are professors and associate professors. In addition, the University employs a score of foreign experts and teachers in relevant specialties and engages 70 senior diplomats, renowned specialists and scholars as guest professors.</p> <p>Entrusted by Ministry of Commerce of the People's Republic of China, CFAU organizes various short and medium-long term training programs for foreign diplomats and officials, which include lectures on Chinese language, international relations, diplomacy, national conditions of contemporary China, news & media, etc. From 1994 to the end of 2015, more than 279 persons from 48 different countries have been trained by the Chinese Language and Culture Training Program, and 3301 persons from over 150 countries have been trained by 166 professional programs. In the year of 2008, authorized by the State Council of China, CFAU became one of the first five national foreign aid training centers of China.</p>

Lectures will include topics such as China's basic national conditions& policies, including China's History and Culture, Basic National Conditions of Contemporary China, China's Economy, China's Foreign Policy and Current International Situation, etc. 2. In Beijing, participants will visit governmental sections, as well as the Great Wall, the Forbidden City, and appreciate traditional folk performances such as Martial Art Show. B. In Guangxi province, participants will visit large enterprises, local featured industries, natural scenery and historical sites, etc. <p>Through this program participants will have a better understanding of China's national conditions and policies. Also, the program is going to equip participants with higher effectiveness in China-related work, and promote communication and cooperation among China and FEALAC Member Countries.</p>
