Therefore, over the recent years, Thailand has shared with international community the application of SEP, our home-grown approach to sustainable development.

Application

- Candidates must be nominated/ endorsed by their respective governments of the eligible countries/territories as well as Australia, Brunei, Japan New Zealand, Republic of Korea and Singapore by the closing date for application.
- Complete nomination documents must be submitted to TICA through the Royal Thai Embassy/ Permanent Mission of Thailand to the United Nations/Royal Thai Consulate-General accredited to eligible countries/ territories.

For Non-AITC-Eligible FEALAC Member Countries - AITC Training Fellowship* include training fee, accommodation, allowance, insurance, airport transfer and social programme.
