The Malaysian Technical Cooperation Programme (MTCP) was officially launched on 7 September 1980 at the Commonwealth Heads of State Meeting in New Delhi, India, to signify Malaysia's commitment to the South-South Cooperation, in particular, the Technical Cooperation among Developing Countries (TCDC).

The MTCP emphasizes on the development of human resources through the provision of trainings in various areas which are essential for a country's development such as the public administration, good governance, health, education, agriculture, sustainable development, poverty alleviation, economy and finance, ICT and environment. Annually, Malaysia offered more than 65 capacity-building and technical assistance programmes under the MTCP, which have benefited more than 34,000 participants from 144 countries.

- To promote South-South Cooperation (SSC); and
- To promote the technical cooperation among developing country.

COURSE BACKGROUND

The spread of coronavirus or also known as Covid-19 has taken the population of the whole world by surprise. The governments of many countries had issued multiple types of Movement Control Orders (MCO) throughout the countries since the World Health Organization (WHO) has declared it as Covid-19 pandemic on 11 March 2020, to control the virus from spreading disastrously throughout their nations.

Since then, most of the business processes and even academic processes need to be conducted from home via on-line and remotely.

The pandemic has expedited the digitalization transformation much faster than we had imagined. Therefore, it is important for organizations to manage their IT services according to internationally recognized standard ISO/IEC 20000-1. During this pandemic, organizations also become more vulnerable to data security threats like hackers, virus, and malicious actions when they conduct their on-line processes remotely.

Therefore, it is very important for the organizations to implement a proper Information Security Management System (ISMS) according to an internationally recognized standard of ISO/IEC 27001.

COURSE OBJECTIVE

- To provide an awareness program on these three subject matters, ITSM according to ISO/IEC 20000-1, ISMS according to ISO/IEC 27001 and BCMS according to ISO 22301 either as an Integrated Management System or separately.
- To provide an overview of these three standards, the general information on the implementation processes and minimum requirements of documentations that are required by the standards. The course also contains the differences and the similarities within the standards besides the benefits and the challenges in implementing the standards.
- To share experience in the development and implementation of these three management systems

COURSE METHODOLOGY

- Overview of ITSM against ISO/IEC 20000-1:2018, ISMS against ISO/IEC 27001:2013 and BCMS against ISO 222301:2019. Similarities and differences of ITSM, ISMS and BCMS and how to integrate the implementation of the three standards as an Integrated Management System (2 days).
- Overview of required documentations including Risk Managements of ITSM, ISMS and BCMS (1 day).
- Benefits and challenges in developing and implementations of ITSM, ISMS and BCMS by a representative from an organization in Malaysia. Sharing sessions by some participants about the status of the implementations of the three standards at their home countries (1 day).

CRITERIA OF APPLICANT

- It is most suitable for junior/middle/senior officers and management who are providing the IT services internally/externally and even for those who are only monitoring the IT services provided to them internally/externally. However, this course is also suitable for those are in-charge of compliance within and organization and for those who are conducting the operational and supporting processes..
- Age between 25 - 50 years old
- Basic knowledge of computers and ICT skills
- Has not participated in any course under MTCP
- Minimal proficiency in English

- Application should be made using prescribed MTCP forms available at: mtcpcoms.kln.gov.my/mtcpcoms/online/list_course
- The application must be completed and endorsed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs / Focal Points responsible for the MTCP Programme in the applicant's country, then submitted through the applicant's government with Note Verbale to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs
- Online training link will be sent out via email to successful candidate
- Incomplete and/or unendorsed forms will not be processed
