As a consequence of the climate change, the duration of the rains has been shortened but its intensity has increased severely. Immediate contingency work has been carried out, such as the "water route", experience acquired in 2018. In this context, the so-called "Water Route" established in 04 districts of the city of Trujillo has the purpose of channeling a probable mudslide that would bring not only water, but also sediments. <b>SDG 11, 13</b>
